SYLLABUS DETAILS

Verbal Reasoning

The GMAT Focus Edition excludes Sentence Correction and emphasizes the following topics:

1. Reading Comprehension

- Comprehend the underlying concept of the passage (approx. 350 words).
- Understand critical ideas and relationships between entities.

2. Critical Reasoning

- o Evaluate arguments structured as debates with five possible answers.
- o Identify elements that affect, strengthen, or weaken the argument.
- Rationally assess arguments and choose the most feasible solution

Quantitative Reasoning

The GMAT Focus Edition includes questions only from Arithmetic and Algebra, excluding Geometry.

Arithmetic Topics

- o Properties of Integers, Fractions, Decimals, Real Numbers
- O Ratio and Proportion, Percentages, Powers and Roots
- Descriptive Statistics, Counting Methods, Discrete Probability, Sets
- O Profit and Loss, Discount

Algebra Topics

- o Simplification of algebraic expressions
- o Solving linear equations with one unknown
- o Solving equations through factoring

Data Insights

This section evaluates analytical and data interpretation skills. An on-screen calculator is provided.


